## 1. Introduction

These Terms and Conditions govern participation in the Chiswick Brass Festival. By attending or participating, you agree to abide by these rules.

## 2. Eligibility

- Participants under 18 must have parental/guardian consent.
- The festival reserves the right to refuse participation to individuals who do not comply with these terms.

## 3. Code of Conduct

- All participants, attendees, and staff must conduct themselves respectfully.
- Disruptive, inappropriate, or unsafe behaviour may result in removal from the festival without refund.

## 4. Liability

- Attendees must provide written consent before any images of minors are used.
- Unauthorised commercial photography is prohibited.

- Refunds will be issued until 2 days prior to the event. Refunds would also be issued if the events were to be canceled by the festival.
